## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

- 1. The name of the school is "Saint Luke's Church of England Primary School".
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of Saint Luke's Church of England Primary School".
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. 2 Parent governors:
  - b. 1 Staff governor:
  - c. 1 Headteacher governor;
  - d. 1 Local Authority governor:
  - e. 7 Foundation governor.;
- 5. Total number of governors: 12
- 6. 6 Foundation Governors shall be appointed as follows:
  - a. The Tower Hamlets Deanery Synod shall appoint Two Foundation Governors;
  - b. The London Diocesan Board for Schools shall appoint Two Foundation Governors;
  - c. The Parochial Church Council of Christ Church, London E14 shall appoint Two Foundation Governors.
- 7. a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: The Officiating Minister of Christ Church, Manchester Road, London E14
  - b. The Archdeacon of Hackney shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.
- 8. The Archdeacon of Hackney shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the exofficio foundation governor referred to in 7a above and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 9. Ethos statement:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian beliefs and practise. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 10. This instrument of government comes into effect on 13th October 2015.
- 11. This instrument was made by order of Tower Hamlets Local Authority on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2015.
- 12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and Headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the London Diocesan Board for Schools.
