Our scooter parking is located next to the cycle parking. We are located next to a newly formed school that shares Glenworth Avenue road entrance. We are within walking distance of the Greenwich foot tunnel.

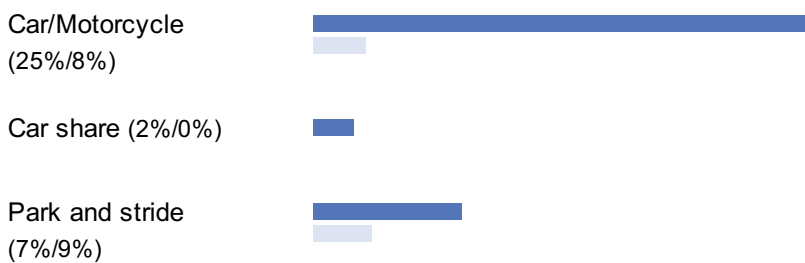

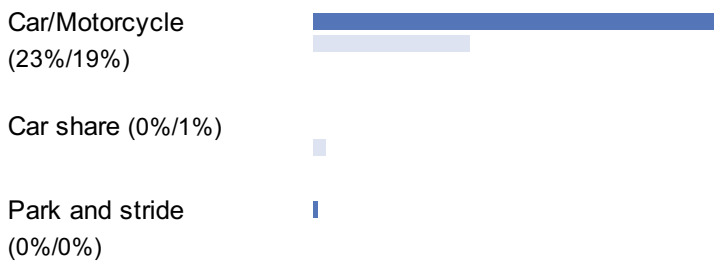
